5 cabins - 4 heads

The gorgeous new Moorings 54.5 was designed with maximum comfort and light and boasts outstanding cruising performance at sea.

It benefits from 4 generous cabins plus and additional crew cabin, saloon and cockpit areas, as well as top-of-the-line features including dual helm, generator, air conditioning, bow thruster, electric winches, inverter, and electric toilets.



#### **HULL & DECK**

Design made following European Directive requirements and according to EC certification:

One piece hull design moulded in polyester resin

Single internal grid unit moulding GRP laminated and attached to hull with marine epoxy

Deck in balsa core and fibreglass sandwich construction with diamond type nonslip surface

Hull and deck joined with screws and marine epoxy. Solid wood bulwark bonded to deck with screws and marine epoxy

Fixed cast iron keel through bolted with stainless steel keel bolts and bonded with marine epoxy

Spade rudder hung with glass composite rudder stock

White gelcoat hull colour

Moorings graphics and striping

Stainless steel stem head fitting with twin anchor bow rollers

#### STEERING SYSTEM

Aft cockpit design featuring twin helm position with engine controls at starboard helm

Two 900 mm diameter leather covered stainless steel steering wheels

Cable throttle and transmission system

Bow thruster

# **MOORING AND ANCHORING**

Self-bailing cockpit locker

Twin bow rollers in stainless steel stem head fitting

1600 w vertical electric windlass with remote control in cockpit and chain counter

8 Aluminium mooring cleats - Stainless steel deck line protection

Cleats at mid ship

Mooring kit (Anchor CQR 34 kg, 85 m of 12 mm chain) - 4 Mooring lines - 6 Fenders

#### SAFETY

1 Half-open stainless steel bow pulpit - Step

2 Stainless steel aft push pits

1 Ring lifebuoy bracket

1 Flag pole socket

Double stainless steel lifelines with no vinyl cover and stainless steel stanchions. Lifeline gates port and starboard

# **BATHING PLATFORM & TRANSOM**

Access door pivoted

1 Life-raft storage locker in transom - 2 doors

1 Stainless steel swimming ladder with transom protection

1 Hot & cold transom shower

1 Outboard engine bracket

# **MAST & STANDING RIGGING**

Standard mast 9/10 electro-polished aluminium installed on the deck, double spreader rig

Boom in anodized aluminium

Stainless steel standing rigging

Single backstay with turnbuckle

Rigid boom vang

Genoa furling system with drum on the deck

Mainsail sheet traveller

2 genoa sheet tracks with piston adjusted traveller cars - 2 Genoa sheet turning blocks

Rigging run back to cockpit (except boom topping lift)

Low stretch topping lift

Complete running rigging: Main halyard, genoa halyard with clutch on mast and cleat, Boom topping lift with cleat on mast, sheet and outhaul, 2 Genoa sheets 2 jiffy reefing lines, 1 manual reef

Lead on mast for genoa halyard

Rope stopper for genoa halyard

11 sheet clutches

# **ENGINE**

Engine Yanmar Diesel 110 hp

Engine compartment: Foam soundproofing - Ventilation: 1 air intake and 1 pressured air outlet

1 Alternator 12 v / 80 Ah

2 Rotomolded diesel tank 63 gal. / 237 l (under aft berths) - Electronic gauge -Low level alarm

Filters: Sea water separator - fuel filters

Fixed three blade propeller

1 Engine access via hinged companionway (opening with gas piston) - 2 Engine access panels in aft cabins

# **ELECTRICAL SYSTEM**

12 v DC circuit - 110 v circuit

4 x house batteries (140 Ah)

Engine start battery (110 Ah)

1 Battery charger 40 Ah - 1 charge divider

Electrical panel (12 v) (Circuit breakers - Voltmeter - Water gauge - Fuel gauge -Battery warning - Fuel warning) 1 Socket(s) 12 v - 7 Socket(s) 110 v

Inverter (2000 w / 12 v / 110 v)

# WATER SYSTEM

3 rotomolded freshwater tanks (2 x 84 gal / 320 l) in the saloon - 86 gal. / 330 l forward cabin) - 2 Deck fillers - Tank selection with ¼ by-pass valves

Pressurised electric water pump - Expansion chamber - System protection filter



Electric water heater 10 gal. / 40 l (Operation off engine or on 110 v electrical system)

Shower discharge pump for each shower. Overboard discharge

2 automatic bilge pumps with float switch

1 Electric ice box drain pump

#### SALOON

Height to deck beam: 6 ft 6 in. / 2.00 m

U-shaped saloon bench with cushions

Saloon table in only 1 piece, Varnished wood top with inlay, Aluminium legs

Saloon table converts to double berth (with cushions)

- 2 person bench seat with central foldaway armrest
- 4 Matching decorative cushions

Cupboards, Cubby hole lockers and storage along the hull, storage under bench seats

- 1 Panoramic window with pleated blinds
- 2 Hull portholes with curtain
- 2 fixed deck house side windows with pleated blinds
- 1 Porthole opening onto coaming in the starboard side window
- 3 Opening deck hatches with blind / mosquito screens

#### **GALLEY**

Height to deck beam: 6 ft 6 in. / 2.02 m

U-shaped kitchen fitted into companionway

Synthetic resin work top

- 1 Stainless steel sink 2 rectangular basins
- Cutting board
- 1 Mixer tap cold water / hot

- 1 Gas cooker with 3 stainless steel burners. Stainless steel oven on mountings, safety bar
- 1 Refrigerator 130 litre, refrigeration unit 12 v, front opening

Fridge drain to overboard with pump & filter

1 Ice box 100 litre, Refrigeration unit 12 v, front opening

1 cutlery drawer

Fitted cupboards and lockers (shelves, stainless steel basin on slider, tea towel holder. Rubbish bin, bottle holder)

1 Porthole opening onto coaming with curtain

Propane solenoid with switch and large warning light in obvious location

Height to deck beam: 6 ft 6 in. / 2.05 m Wooden companionway with steps in moulded wood with nonslip surface

2 Stainless steel quardrails

# **FORWARD HEADS**

Height to deck beam: 1.92 m

Head unit moulded in one piece

Separate shower - shower mixer tap hot / cold water - Shower guard in PMMA

Large electric marine toilets

1 blackwater holding tank (21 gal. / 80 l) in each head

Washbasin - Synthetic resin work top - Mixing tap hot water / cold water

Mirror

Toilet accessories: Glass holder, soap tray, towel rail, Rubbish bin, Paper dispenser

Cupboard and cubby hole

1 Opening deck hatch with blind / Mosquito screen

# AFT HEAD

Height to deck beam: 6 ft 7 in. / 2.05 m

Head unit moulded in one piece

Separate shower, shower mixer tap hot / cold water, 2 door shower cabinet in PMMA

Large electric marine toilet

1 blackwater holding tank (21 gal. / 80 l)

Washbasin - Synthetic resin work top - Mixing tap hot / cold water

Mirror

Toilet Accessories: Glass holder, soap tray, towel, trash bin, paper dispenser

Cupboard and cubby hole

- 1 Fitted deck house side window with curtain
- 1 Porthole opening onto coaming with curtain

# **NAVIGATION STATION**

Control console with flap - glove boxes - storage - moulded wood beading

Navigation seat with cushion

Hinged electrical panel enabling access to electrical connections

Navigation instrument panel

Radio CD player / Stereo MP3 with 2 loud speakers

White/red navigation light

Stainless steel hand rail on partition

#### FORE CABINS

Height to deck beam: 6 ft 4 in. / 1.95 m

Double bed (6 ft 6 in. / 2.00 m x 4 ft 11 in. / 1.50 m x 3 ft 3 in. / 1.00 m) - Marine mattress

Hanging locker - Cupboards - Cubby hole lockers - glove boxes - Drawer

1 hull porthole with curtain

#### AFT CABINS

Symmetrical cabins each one consisting of:

Height to deck beam: 6 ft 10 in. / 2.10 m

Double bed (6 ft 6 in. / 2 m x 5 ft 3 in. / 1.60 m x 4 ft 3 in. / 1.30 m), Marine mattress

Hanging locker, Cubby hole lockers, central storage, glove boxes

Mirror

- 1 Hull portholes with curtain
- 1 Porthole opening onto coaming with curtain
- 1 Porthole opening onto cockpit with curtain
- 1 Opening deck hatch(es) with blind / mosquito screen

Access door to aft washroom in starboard cabin

# **BOW CABIN**

Access through deck hatch - stainless steel ladder, steps

Cabin -- single bed (6 ft 6 in. / 2.00 m x 2 ft 2 in. / 0.65 m x 1 ft 7 in. 0.50 m) - Foam mattress

Cubby hole locker

Hanging locker

Drawers

Washroom: Moulded in one piece to be watertight.

Washbasin - 1 mixing tap with hot/cold water - valve / shower

Manual toilet

Mirror

1 cupboard
